These books are specially made with love and care by the Katha team, for 5 to 12 year olds.

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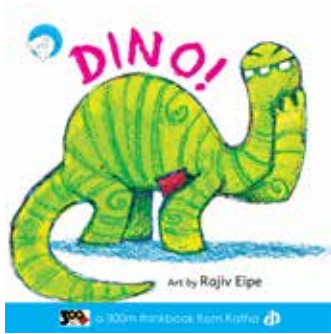
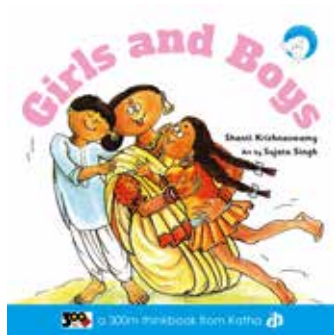
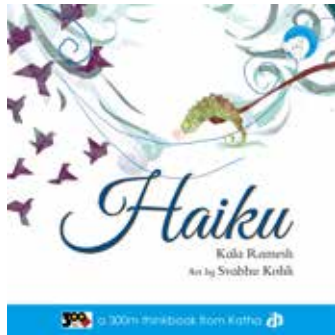
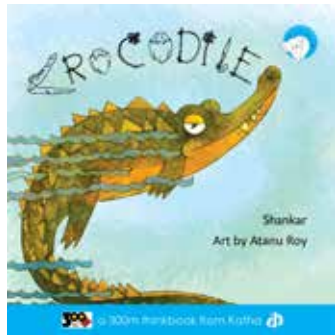
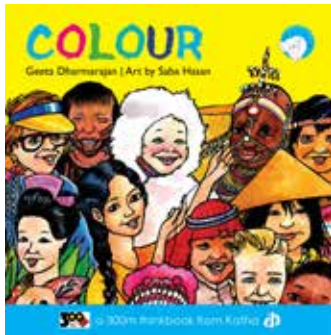
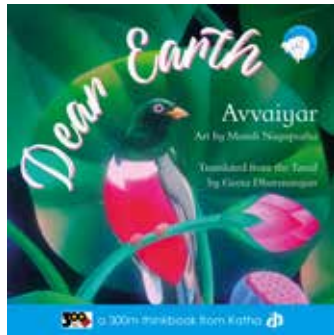
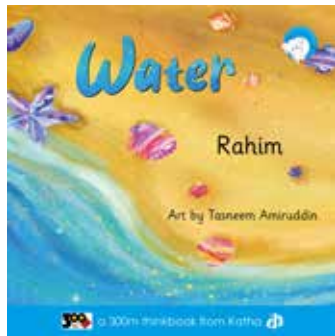
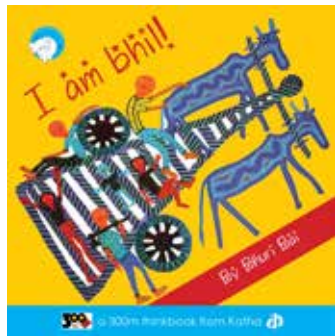
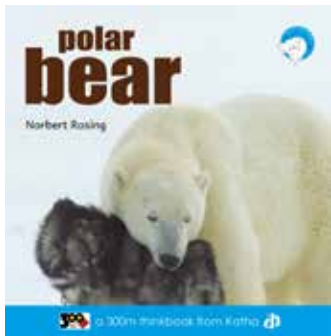
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
