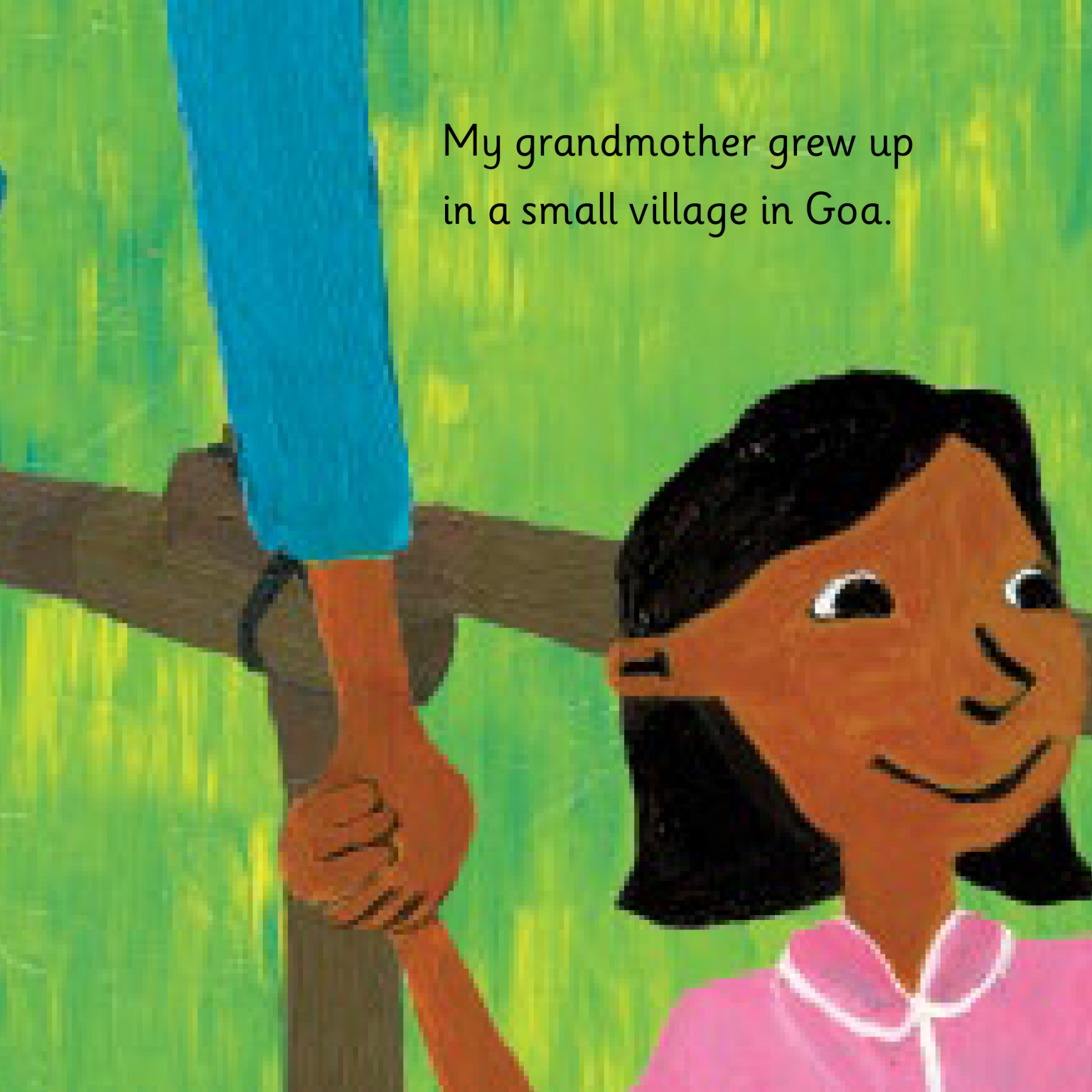

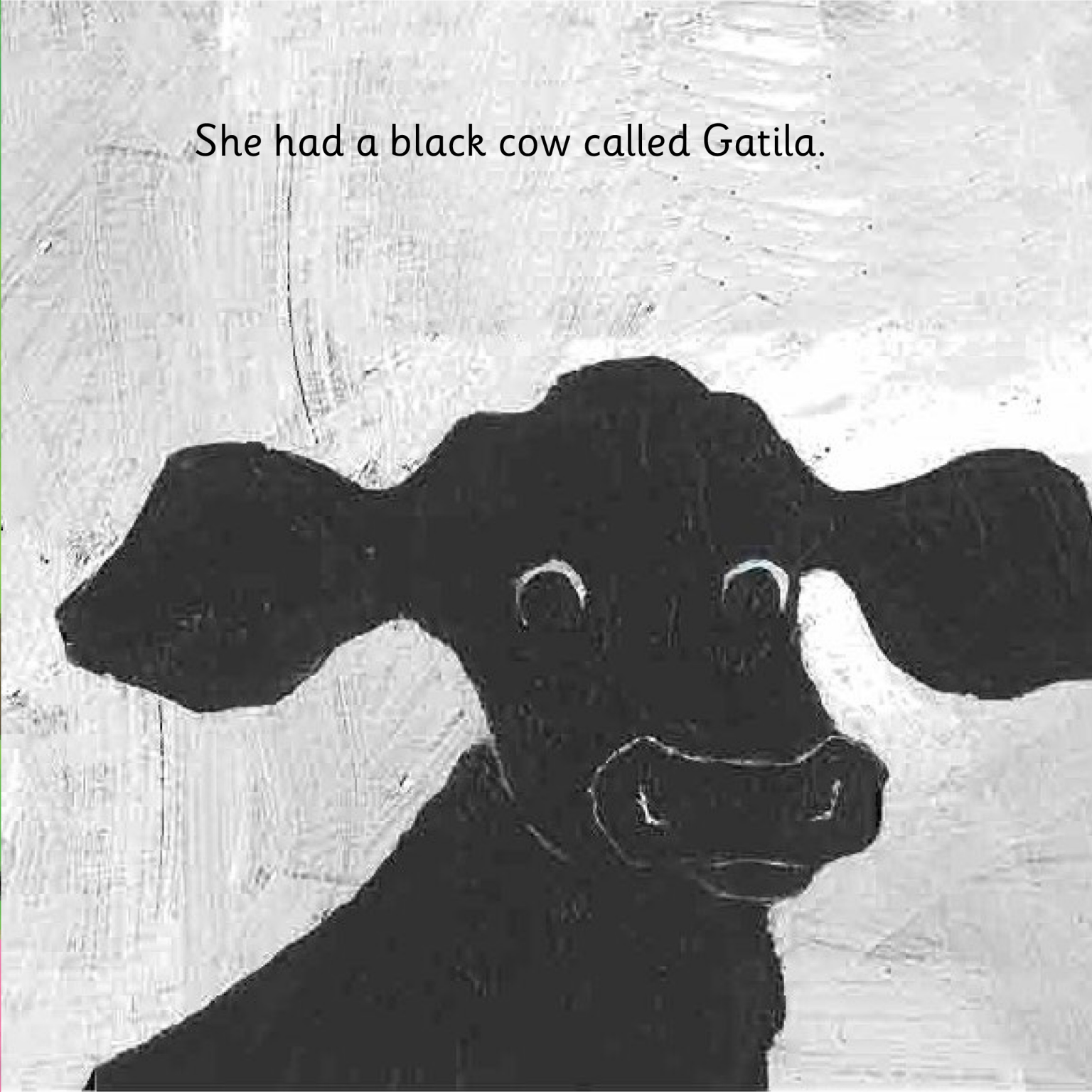

She had a black cow called Gatila.

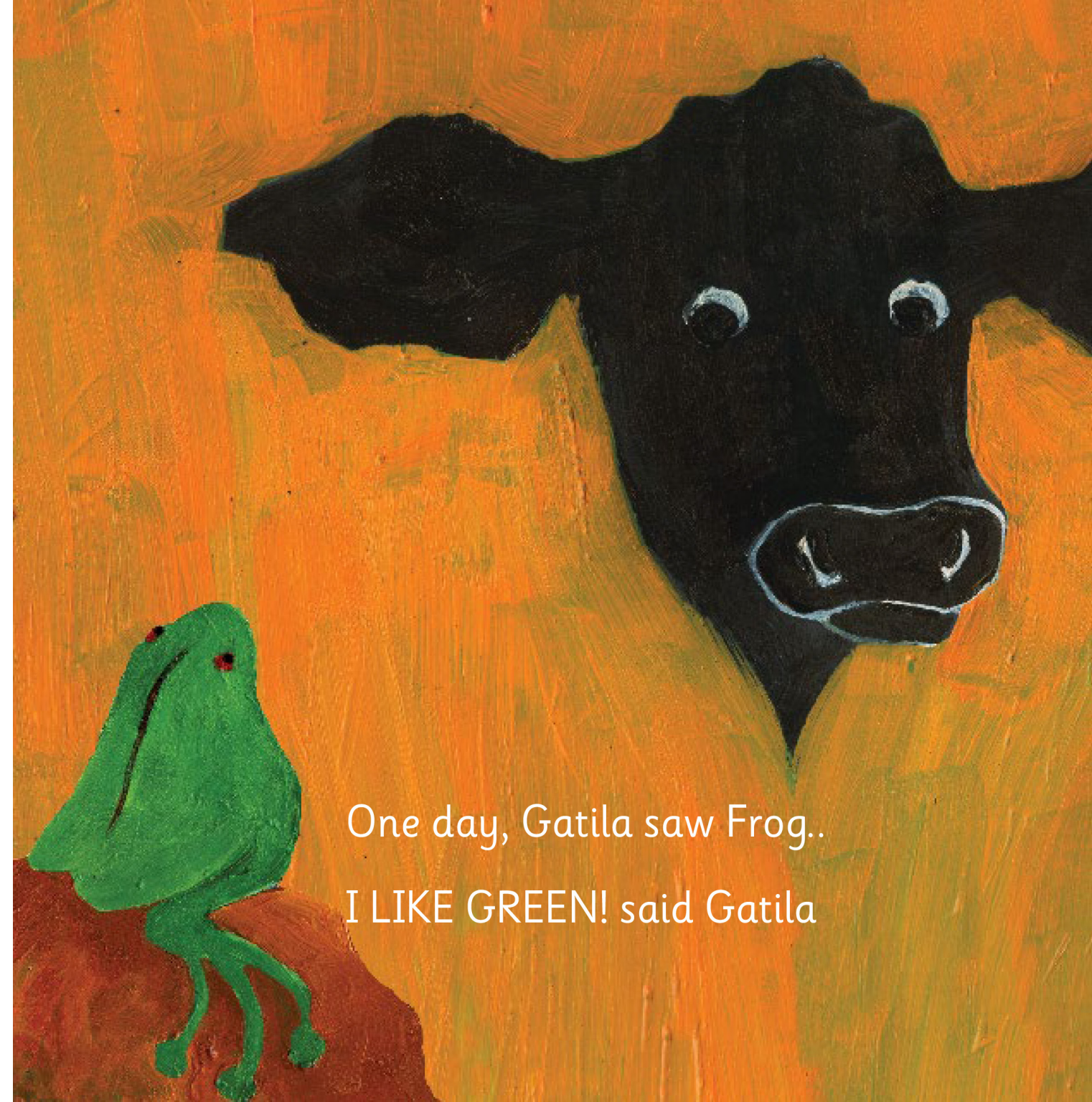




Gatila was happy

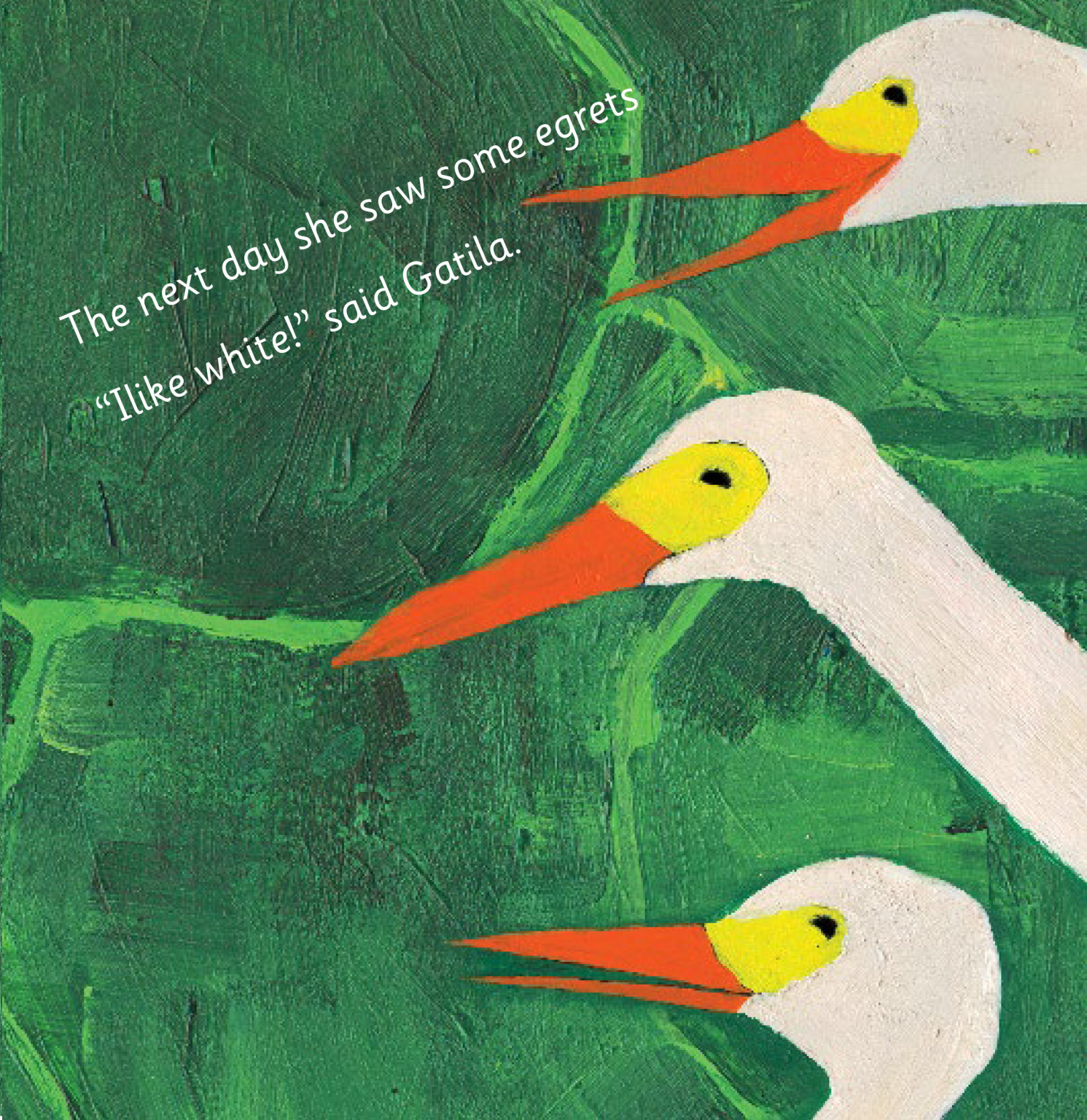

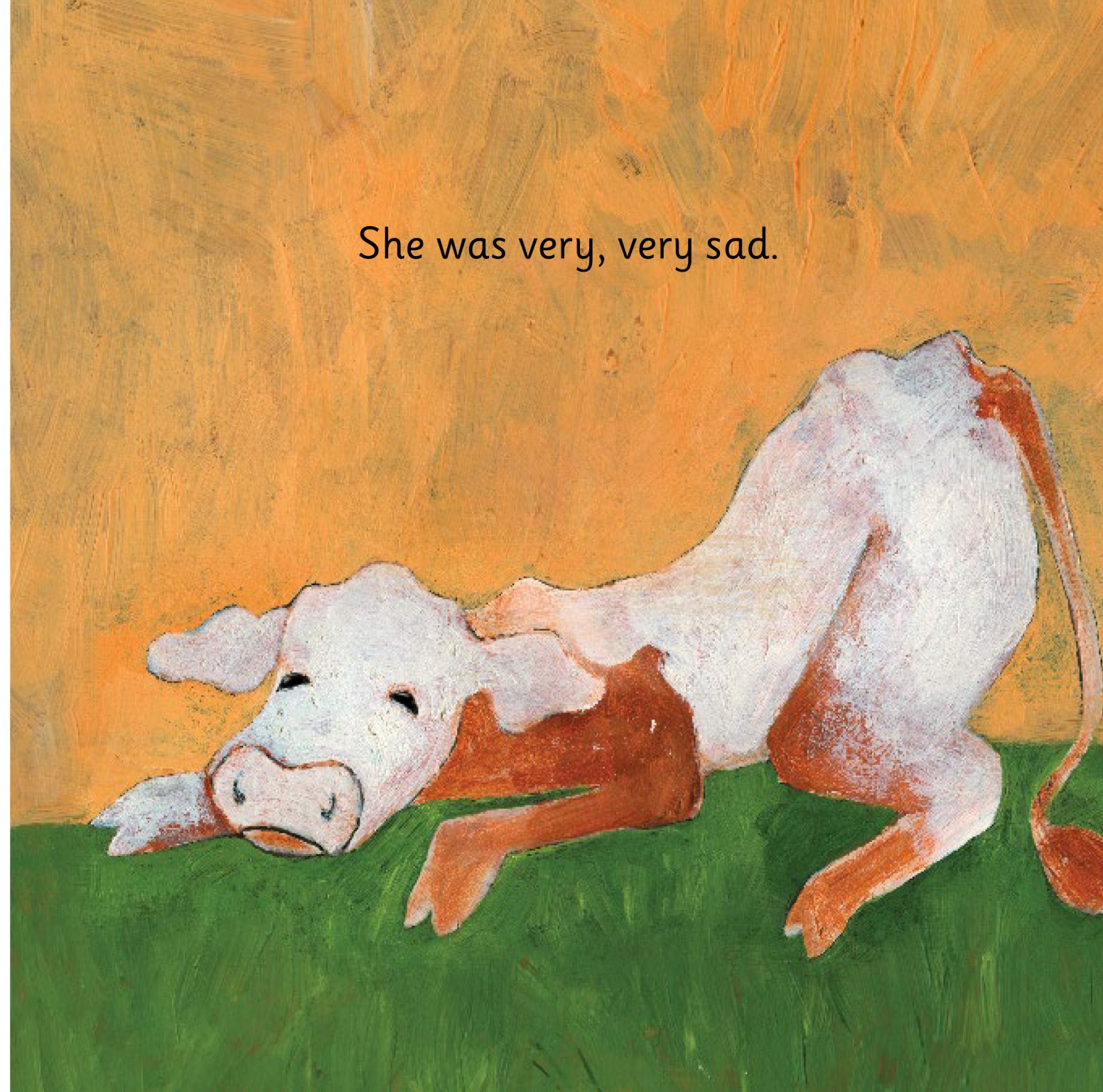
