be tigers!

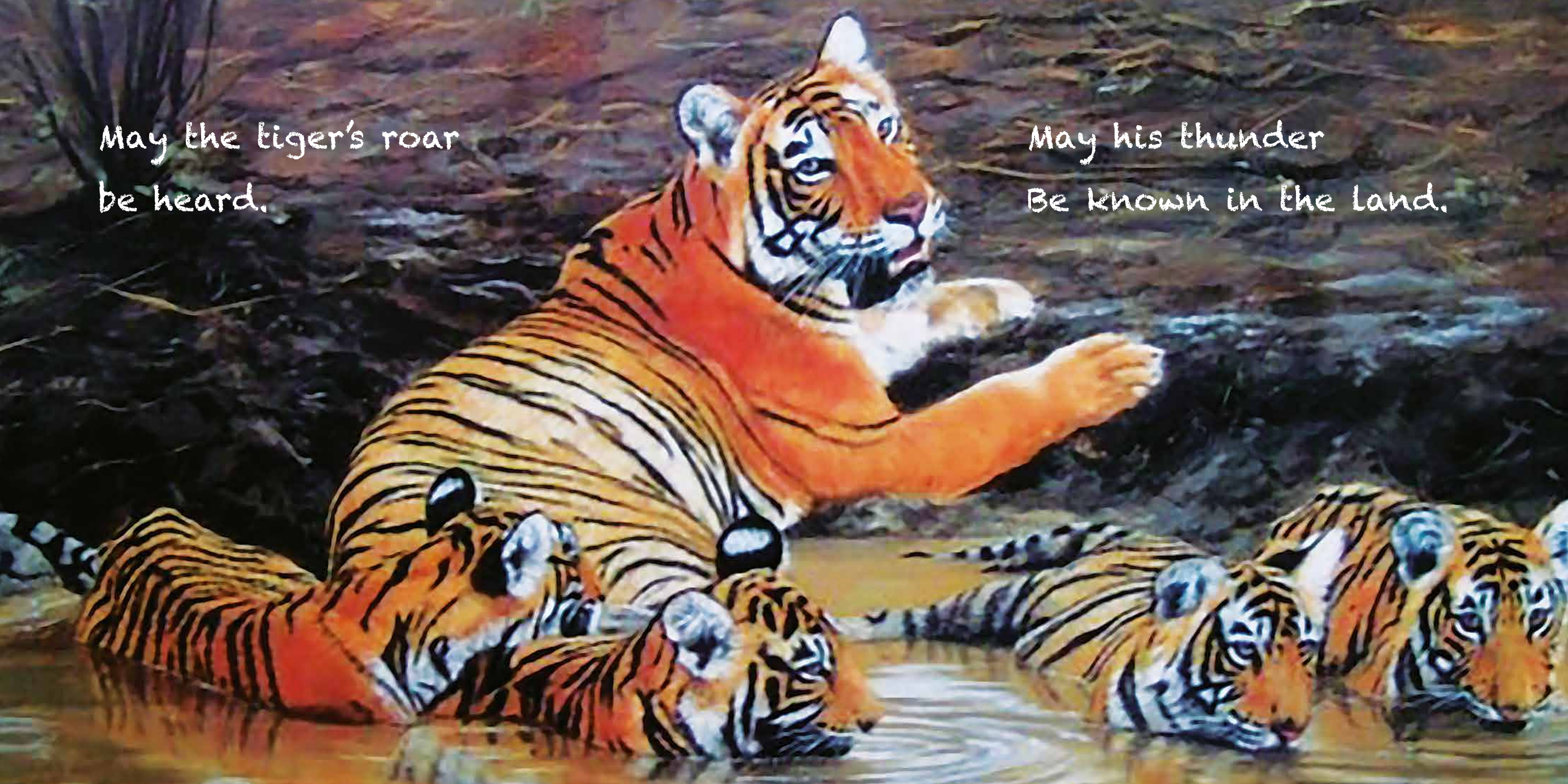


In the jungles,


At the forest pool,
