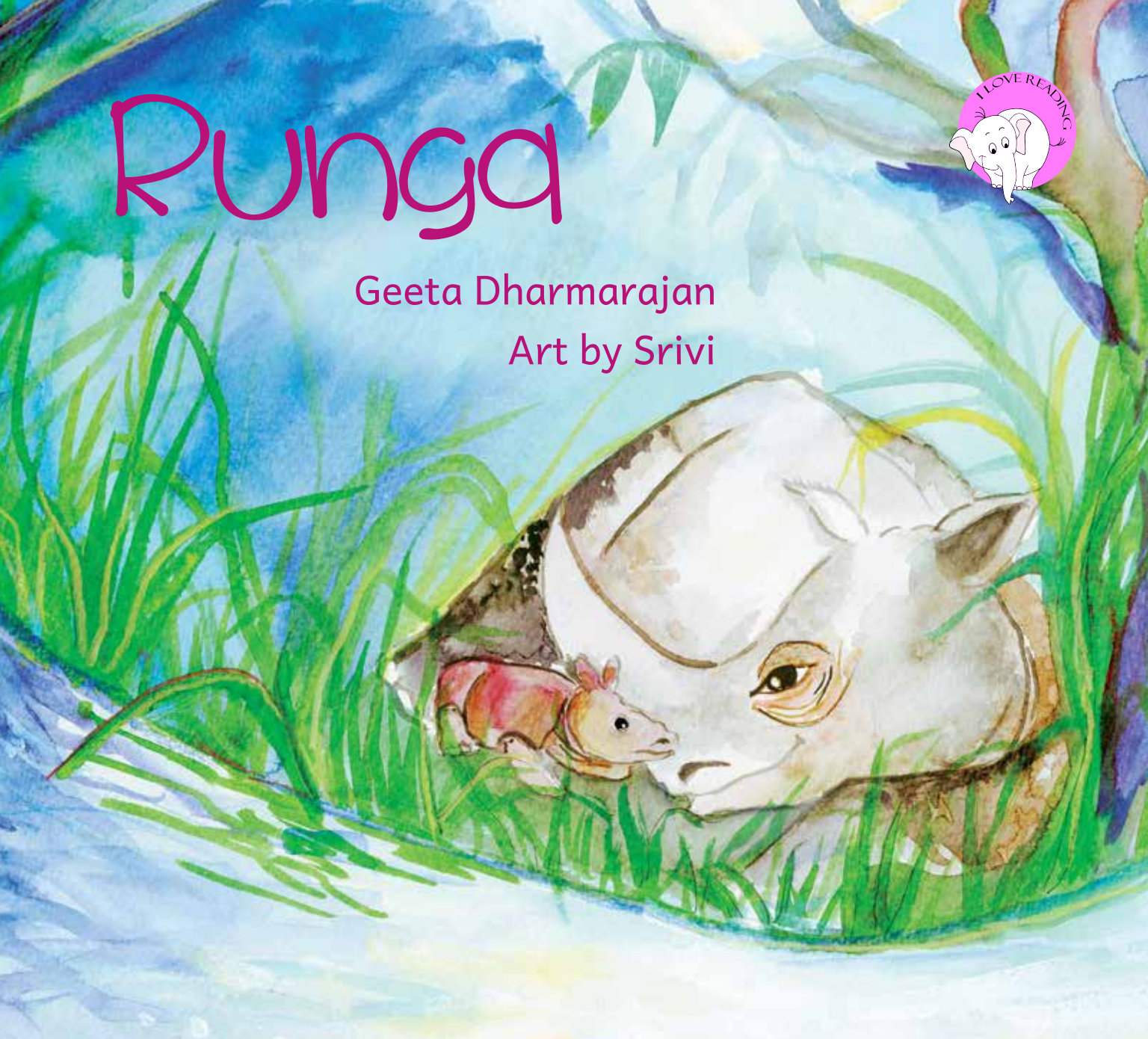

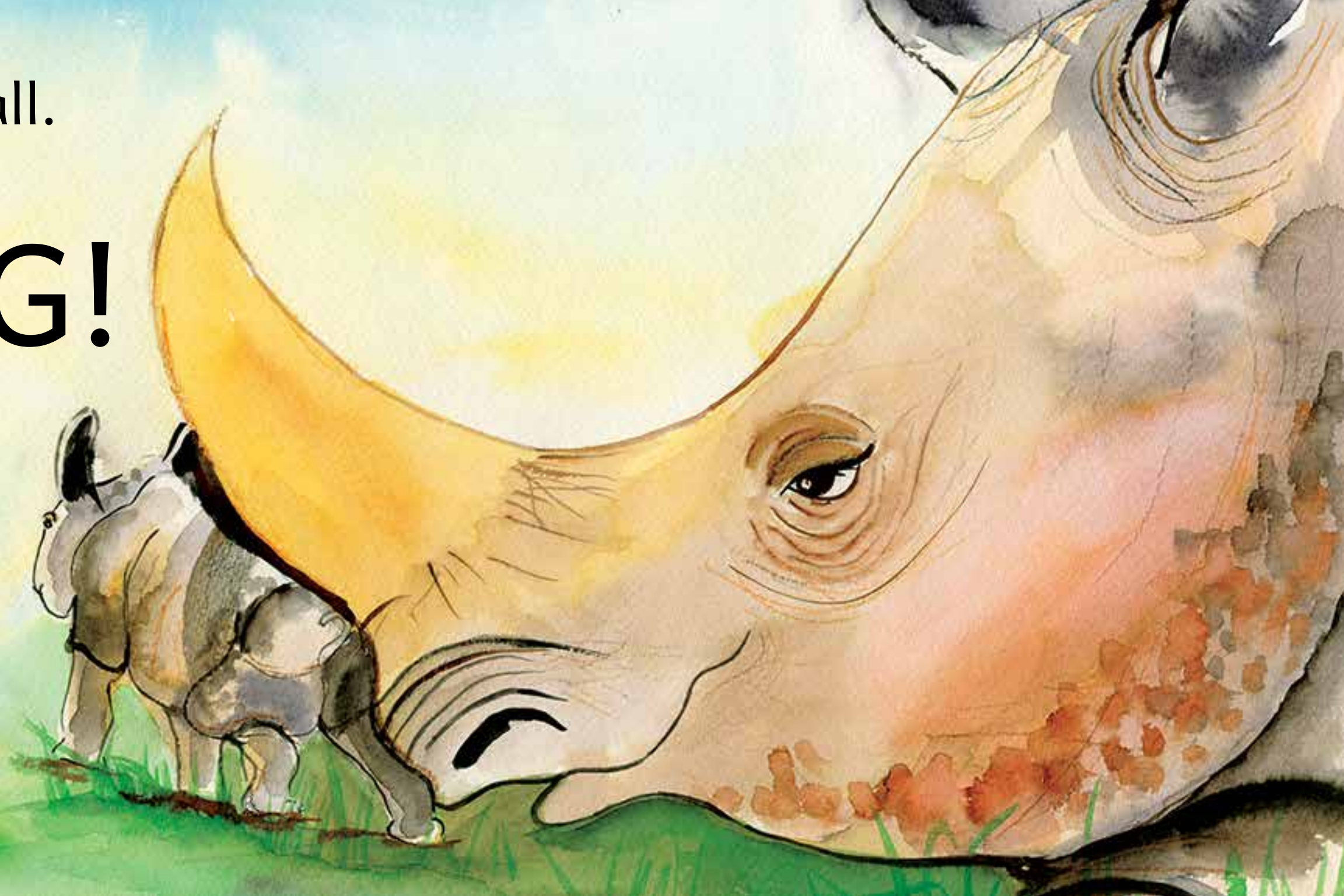


I am Runga,

I am so, so small.

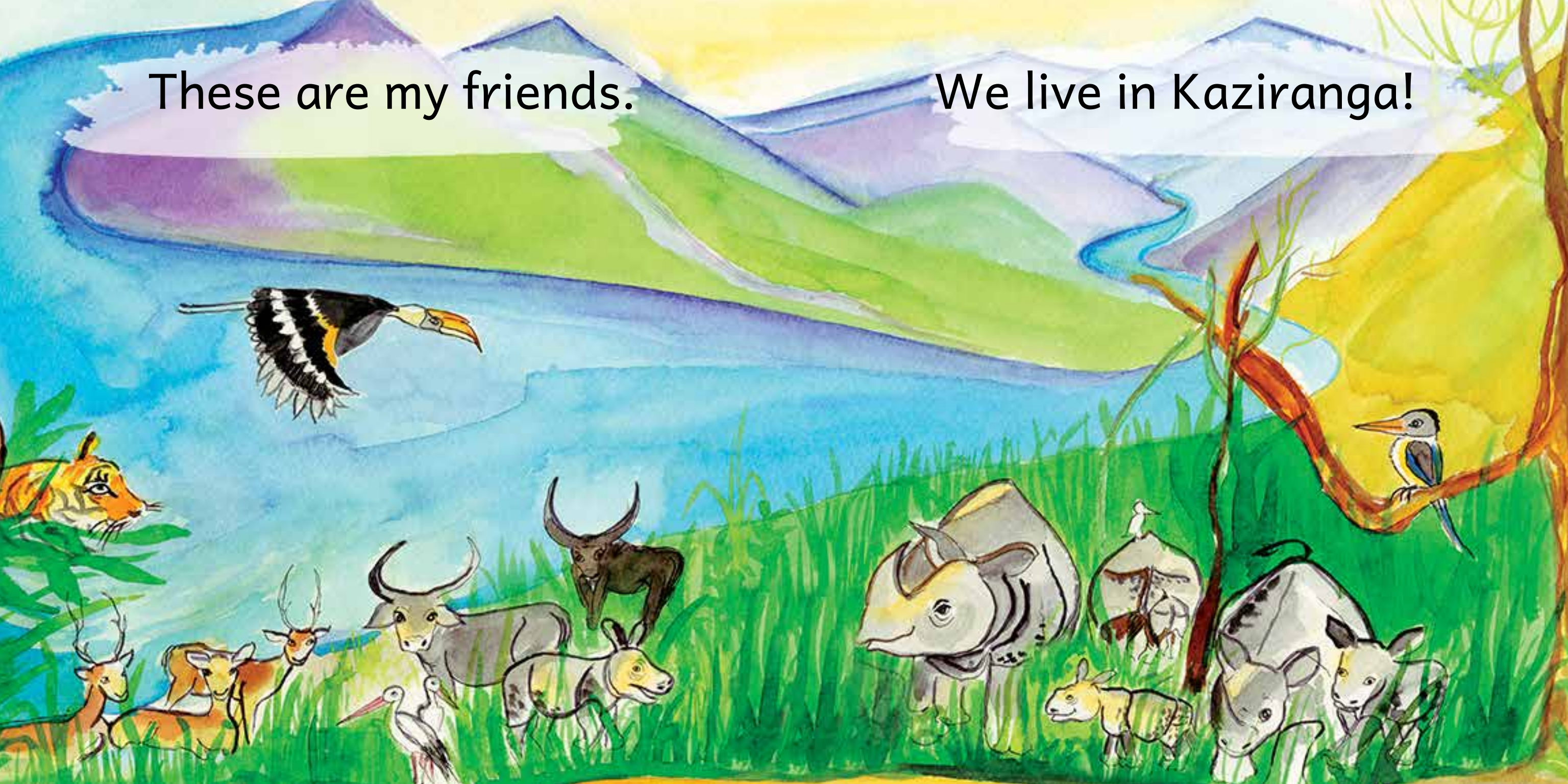
Amma is so,

Take your child from wordless books to books with 1200 words.

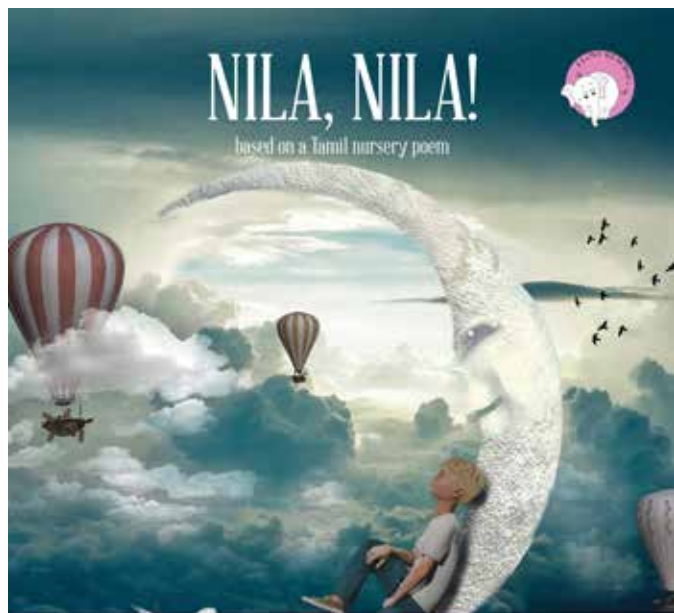
