What?

Flowers play an important role in the reproduction of plants, but they have a number of important uses for humans as well. Since prehistoric times, humans have used flowers, stems and other plant parts for a variety of different purposes, from simple decorations to matters of survival.

Shall we walk up to see those pink lilies?



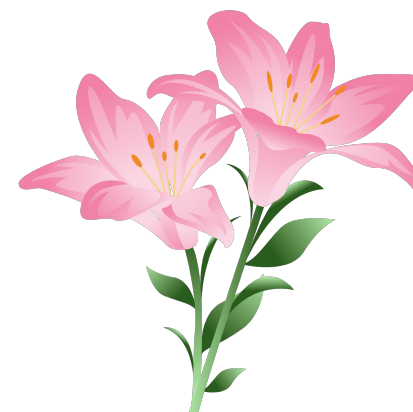
Aren't they beautiful?
